

Child Care Resources of Rockland – Strategic Plan 2021-23

Approved by the Board of Directors May 22, 2021

- 1. Meet all CCRR contract milestones and audit requirements.
- 2. Provide families fair access to licensed/regulated child care.
 - a. We will provide information to families on what to look for in a quality child care and educational programs.
 - b. We will provide opportunities for parents to learn about developmentally appropriate practice; types of child care available; and accessing other resources available to them.
- 3. Assure child care programs have access to professional development and technical assistance that supports the delivery of developmentally appropriate practice by a well-trained workforce and enables programs meet regulatory requirements.
 - a. CCRR will provide child care providers to access varied professional development opportunities to meet regulatory requirements, including trainings offered by CCRR staff.
 - b. CCRR will provide both basic and intensive technical assistance to child care providers.

4. Communicate and Advocate

- a. Maintain current and relevant information to share with all stakeholders.
- b. Bi-lingual communications/publications
- c. Improve data collection and analysis with the hiring of a data and operations associate.
- d. Increase engagement with email, social media, and website.
- e. Continue monthly provider networking sessions.

5. Support and grow governance and operations.

- a. Staff
 - i. Agency will undertake Succession Planning for 2021 address upcoming retirements and potential restructuring.
 - ii. Afford staff professional development opportunities, especially those to maintain credentials/licenses.
 - iii. Cross-train agency staff to assure contract requirements will be met.
 - iv. Develop a technology strategic plan.
- b. Board
 - i. Board members are trained.
 - ii. Board members reflective of community.
 - iii. Meets the goals of the agency Strategic and subordinate plans.
 - iv. Board remains apprised of agency operations.
- c. Agency
 - i. Maintain accreditation/Meet NYS Standards of Excellence (SOEs)
 - ii. Conduct surveys to gain insights from stakeholders about changing/emerging child care needs.
 - iii. Seek targeted funding opportunities to meet determined agency and community needs.
