- Quality Enhancement Specialists are available to offer technical assistance, consultation, training and education to child care providers, service providers and families.

- Community/Business Education and Advocacy.

Special Needs Services for Families

Family Connections Specialists assist families who are seeking child care programs or other resources to meet their needs. There are many questions a family may have concerning the unique needs of their children. Rockland County is fortunate to be a Unified Services County, which enables families to benefit from the collaborative efforts of service agencies. Family Connections Specialists put families in touch with appropriate agencies both private and public such as: inclusive child care programs, therapeutic programs, evaluation services, advocacy groups, health department, preventive and crisis services, drug and alcohol agencies and many others.

Respite Child Care

Through Family Support Services grants, CCRR offers some respite care funding. Respite care is provided by child care programs, both home or center-based. These child care professionals have experience, knowledge, and a great deal of caring.

To be considered for respite care funding **one** of the following eligibility requirements must apply:

- **The child has a developmental disability, or;**
- **The child has an emotional disorder or;**
- **The parent or guardian has a mental illness.**

School Holiday Vacation Respite Care

Families in need of child care during school holidays and whose school age child has a disability or special need can use either a home-based or a school-age child care center for care during this time.

Reimbursement is made available to the provider by CCRR.
